

How do I get to the Finland-Institut?

Arrival:

- by public transport [distance from the Finland-Institut]:

a) Bus: M19, M29 Europa-Center [100 m]

b) Underground: U3 Augsburger Straße [350 m] U1, U3, U9 Kurfürstendamm [400 m] U1, U2, U3, Wittenbergplatz [600 m]

c) S-bahn/Regional trains: Zoologischer Garten station [600 m]

- by car [distance from the Finland-Institut]:

Parking spaces are available at the Contipark car park at Los Angeles-Platz (subject to a fee) [500 m]

Please note that there are currently scaffolding structures near the Institute building. In addition, temporary covered walkways have been installed for pedestrians. This may cause uneven surfaces, creating an immediate risk of tripping. This also applies to all adjacent pavements.

Access to the building at Marburger Straße 3:

The Finland-Institut is located on the first floor to the right.

Notice (also relevant for people with reduced mobility):

At present, access is only possible under difficult conditions, as one, in order to reach the building, has to:

a) climb three stone steps (without a handrail on the banister), and

b) push the heavy entrance door inwards to open.

All the Finland-Institut's premises are situated on a flat floor.

However, there are raised thresholds between the rooms (height 1.0 - 1.3 cm), which is an obstacle.

Further information for persons with reduced mobility:

- On the ground floor there is a lift on the right-hand side (door width 79 cm, dimensions 86 x 199 cm).

- The passage leading to the lift has a maximum width of 82 cm and provides sufficient space for wheelchairs, prams and walking aids.
